- An acknowledgement that children need to revisit and systematically build on their skills, therefore opportunities are provided for pupils to speak with increasing confidence, fluency and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating what they want to say.
- Children are immersed in age-appropriate opportunities to write at varying lengths, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures that they have learnt.
- The foreign language curriculum provides practical opportunities to apply and deepen their skills and knowledge in the core curriculum subjects ensuring that they can understand the rationale behind learning in these areas.
- A curriculum that contributes towards pupils discovering and developing an appreciation of a range of writing in French.
