This week in Preschool has been all about plant and butterfly life cycles.

We have learnt the "tiny caterpillar" song and the children have created their own symmetrical butterflies. They used corks to print on one side of their butterfly, then they folder their paper before revealing their beautiful symmetrical patterns.

The children have learnt the difference between a cocoon and a chrysalis, they know that moths emerge from a cocoon and butterflies emerge from chrysalis.

The children noticed changes in the plants. They pointed out the seed heads from the daffodils and the dandelion clocks, using vocabulary and their knowledge from previous weeks.

We have begun Read, Write, Inc. with some groups of children this week, the children have been very enthusiastic. They have learnt the sounds 'm' and 'a'.
