

The big question:

What does it mean if God is loving and holy?

Key Vocabulary:

- Omnipotent: having unlimited power
- Omnipresent: widely or constantly encountered; widespread
- Omniscient: knowing everything
- Eternal: lasting or existing forever; without end
- Justice: just behaviour or treatment
- Almighty: having complete power
- Holy: dedicated or consecrated to God or a religious purpose; sacred

Learning Outcomes:

- To make connections between biblical texts and what Christians believe about God, e.g. through how churches are designed
- To show how Christians put their beliefs into practice in worship
