## **PE Kit**

## Spellings, reading and homework.

Towards the beginning of each term, children will be sent home with a sheet of week-by-week spellings. The new spellings will be introduced to the children in school, weekly on Mondays. Children are expected to practice these spelling words at home, and they will then be tested on these spellings the following Monday.

Children will bring their reading books home from school, which will be in line with the children's AR levels. We continue to ask that **all children** read at home at least **five times a week** and kindly ask that an adult signs the reading record to record this has been done).



TT rockstars should also be used regularly to support the children in practicing their times tables. Times tables will be a big focus for the children this year as they will be completing the multiplication check towards the end of their time in year 4.
