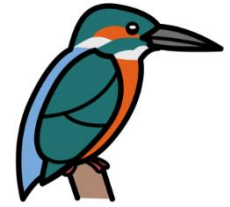


Welcome to Kingfisher Class!



Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you all had a restful and enjoyable summer. I'm very much looking forward to getting to know your children over the coming year and supporting them as they grow, learn, and thrive in Kingfisher Class!

To begin the term, we will be exploring the whole-school text, *Here We Are* by Oliver Jeffers. This will be a lovely way to reconnect as a school community and set the tone for a thoughtful, creative year ahead. Following this, we will move into our daily Read Write Inc. (RWI) programme for phonics, reading, and writing.

Reading at Home

We ask that all children to read at home where possible at least five times a week. Please ensure you sign the reading record to confirm this has been completed. In the early weeks, your child will bring home a 'reading for pleasure' book. These are intended to be read *to* your child, as they may not yet be able to decode the text independently.

From Week 3, your child will also begin bringing home a RWI reading book. This will directly reflect the sounds and words they have been learning in class and is intended for them to read *with* you. These books will be changed once the children complete the in-school lessons based on the following text. For reception parents, children will not bring home a RWI reading book until they have been assessed as knowing enough Set 1 sounds to be able to begin decoding simple stories.

Spellings and Assessments

Year 1 children will soon begin bringing home spellings to practise. These will include a mix of phonics-based words covered during the week, as well as Year 1 Common Exception Words, which are words that often don't follow regular phonetic rules. Weekly spelling tests will take place every Monday, with new spellings going out the same day.

Staffing and Support

Kingfisher Class is taught by myself. On Monday afternoons, Computing and PE will be taught by Mrs Rushworth and a TLE sport coach. The class will also be supported throughout the week by Mrs Burrell, Miss Hookins, and Mrs Barnard, who all play a valuable role in supporting your child's learning.

PE Information

PE lessons will take place on Mondays with our sports coach, as well as another day in the week with me. Please ensure that your child keeps their PE kit in school at all times. Unlike other classes, Kingfishers will *not* come to school in their PE kit on PE days; instead, they will

get changed at school. We will send home PE kits at the end of each half term (or sooner if needed!)
